

The Station Hub, Mytholmroyd



For nearly ten years, volunteers from the station adoption group - Mytholmroyd Station Partnership have been working on trying to get the station building repaired and reused. Early ideas were for studio space for local artists and community use.

The new Northern franchisee Agreement includes the Mytholmroyd station building as one of the two stations specifically mentioned for renovation for social use.

The owners, Network Rail have stated they plan to renovate the building using their own funds to the original layout with the Railway Heritage Trust planning to restore the historic features Northern intend to pay towards some of the Refurbishment works.

Based on the local community interest at previous Public meetings, a new local charity was formed in September 2017, the Station Building Group (CIO No. 1174609) to assist with the re-opening of the Building.

The Trustees have commissioned an independent consultant to do a **Feasibility Study to check what new uses might be viable.**

The Consultants have undertaken a wide survey Involving many businesses, organisations and residents with regard to possible uses.

The Consultants, Rose Regeneration Ltd will be In attendance to outline their proposals at the - Meeting at the Good Shepherd Centre on Monday 5th February at 19.00hrs.
